

SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT FOUNDATION PRIVACY POLICY

Under articles 13 and 14 of the Privacy Regulations UE/679/2016 ("GDPR") we inform you that the personal data you voluntarily provide to the Sustainable Development Foundation (hereinafter Susdef) , for yourself or on behalf of your organization, in occasion of initiatives, events, exhibitions, conferences or workshop, are processed in observance of the principles of fairness, lawfulness, proportionality, security and accuracy and of other regulatory obligations.

Data are processed especially regarding participants to the events organised by Susdef. Data are processed with paper tools or with the aid of electronic, automated, computer or telecom tools. We process data with: I) paper or on-line forms or with app; II) via mobile devices such as smartphone or tablet or other device present at venue; III) business cards delivered. The data received will be processed electronically and/or manually by our employees and by persons expressly authorized.

The personal data processing has the following purposes:

- a) planning and organizational management of the event to which you registered;
- b) subscribing to the Sustainable Development Foundation newsletter and approval to receive non-commercial communications regarding the field of interest declared by the participant during the registration. The registration implies a direct consent by means of flag affixed at the bottom of the registration form.

The legal basis of the processing referred to point a) is the execution of pre-contractual measures and the contract of which the interested is a part of (art. 6 par. 1 lit b) GDPR). The legal basis of the processing referred to point b) is the consent of the interested part (art. 6 par. 1 lit. a) GDPR).

During the event, recordings and/or pictures are taken by us and/or by photographers and videomakers authorized by Susdef. Such images or films can be used for publication on our websites/landing pages and social accounts (es. Twitter, Facebook, Whatsapp, Youtube, Linkedin etc) and on brochures, catalogues, magazines, flyer and other printed materials.

The required consent can be freely denied, without prejudice to its right to attend the venue.

Data provided are managed by Susdef through the use of computer systems and are not given to third parties. We process data during 10 years from the date of collection.

Subject's rights

You have the right to:

- ask for the confirmation that your data are being processed and, in this case, to access such data;
- ask for rectification of inaccurate data;
- revoke, in any moment, your consent to data treatment, when previously given;
- receive in a structured, common use and readable format from a technological device your personal data, previously given;
